SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 106/65 new 215 ILCS 170/52.5 new 305 ILCS 5/5-5.05 new 330 ILCS 125/37 new

Amends the Children's Health Insurance Program Act, the Covering ALL KIDS Insurance Act, the Illinois Public Aid Code, and the Veterans' Health Insurance Program Act. Provides that the fee schedule for each of these programs must be competitive with those of non-governmental, third-party health insurance programs. Provides that (i) reimbursement for any service must not be lower than Medicare reimbursement in effect on December 31, 2007; (ii) the fee schedule must be decreased or increased every January 1 corresponding to the decrease or increase in the Consumer Price Index for medical care published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, but in no case more than 4% per year; and (iii) payment for services must be made within 30 days after receipt of a bill or claim for payment. Effective July 1, 2008.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning insurance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Children's Health Insurance Program Act is amended by adding Section 65 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 106/65 new)
- 7 Sec. 65. Competitive fee schedule. The fee schedule for the Plan must be competitive with those of non-governmental, 8 9 third-party health insurance programs. Reimbursement for any service must not be lower than Medicare reimbursement in effect 10 on December 31, 2007. The fee schedule must be decreased or 11 12 increased every January 1 corresponding to the decrease or increase in the Consumer Price Index for medical care published 13 14 by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, but in no case more than 4% per year. Payment for services must be made within 30 15 16 days after receipt of a bill or claim for payment in accordance
- Section 10. The Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act is amended by adding Section 52.5 as follows:

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Sec. 52.5. Fee Schedule. The fee schedule for the Covering

- ALL KIDS Insurance Program must be competitive with those of 1 2 non-governmental, third-party health insurance programs. 3 Reimbursement for any service must not be lower than Medicare 4 reimbursement in effect on December 31, 2007. The fee schedule 5 must be decreased or increased every January 1 corresponding to 6 the decrease or increase in the Consumer Price Index for medical care published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, 7 but in no case more than 4% per year. Payment for services must 8 9 be made within 30 days after receipt of a bill or claim for 10 payment in accordance with Section 368a of the Illinois 11 Insurance Code.
- Section 15. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 5-5.05 as follows:

15 Sec. 5-5.05. Competitive fee schedule. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, the fee schedule for the 16 17 program must be competitive with those of non-governmental, third-party health insurance programs. Reimbursement for any 18 19 service must not be lower than Medicare reimbursement in effect 20 on December 31, 2007. The fee schedule must be decreased or 21 increased every January 1 corresponding to the decrease or 22 increase in the Consumer Price Index for medical care published 23 by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, but in no case more than 4% per year. Payment for services must be made within 30 24

- days after receipt of a bill or claim for payment in accordance
- with Section 368a of the Illinois Insurance Code.
- 3 Section 20. The Veterans' Health Insurance Program Act is
- 4 amended by adding Section 37 as follows:

- 6 Sec. 37. Competitive fee schedule. The fee schedule for the
- 7 Program must be competitive with those of non-governmental,
- 8 third-party health insurance programs. Reimbursement for any
- 9 service must not be lower than Medicare reimbursement in effect
- on December 31, 2007. The fee schedule must be decreased or
