2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The State Police Act is amended by adding 5 Section 24 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 2610/24 new)

Sec. 24. Officers; in-car cameras. An officer of the Department of State Police who is operating a police vehicle equipped with an operable in-car video camera system shall have the system recording activities outside the police vehicle while the police vehicle's emergency lighting system is activated.

Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that may 13 14 exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head under the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to make or 15 16 promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this 17 amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly. If, however, the Governor believes that rules are necessary to implement or 18 19 enforce the provisions of this amendatory Act of the 95th 20 General Assembly, the Governor may suggest rules to the General 21 Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and 22 Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the General Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those 23

1	suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action
2	in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this
3	amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly shall be
4	interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other
5	Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise
6	explicitly given. For the purposes of this Section, "rules" is
7	given the meaning contained in Section 1-70 of the Illinois
8	Administrative Procedure Act, and "agency" and "agency head"
9	are given the meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of
10	the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act to the extent that
11	such definitions apply to agencies or agency heads under the
12	jurisdiction of the Governor.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
