AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is 5 amended by changing Section 108-1 as follows:
- 6 (725 ILCS 5/108-1) (from Ch. 38, par. 108-1)

7 Sec. 108-1. Search without warrant.

8 (1) When a lawful arrest is effected a peace officer may 9 reasonably search <u>the</u> the person arrested and the area within 10 such person's immediate presence for the purpose of:

11 (a) protecting the officer from attack; or

12 (b) preventing the person from escaping; or

13

(c) discovering the fruits of the crime; or

(d) discovering any instruments, articles, or things
which may have been used in the commission of, or which may
constitute evidence of, an offense.

17 (2) (Blank).

(3) A law enforcement officer may not search or inspect a
motor vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely
because of a violation of Section 12-603.1 of the Illinois
Vehicle Code.
