1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6010

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6010, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu
4 thereof the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The amount of \$13,091,050, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
8 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
9 Representatives for furnishing the items provided in Section
10 4 of the General Assembly Compensation Act to members of
11 their respective houses throughout the year in connection
12 with their legislative duties and responsibilities and not in
13 connection with any political campaign as prescribed by law.
14 Of this amount, 37.436% is appropriated to the President of

1 the Senate for such expenditures and 62.564% is appropriated
2 to the Speaker of the House for such expenditures.

3 Section 10. Payments from the amounts appropriated in
4 Section 5 hereof shall be made only upon the delivery of a
5 voucher approved by the member to the State Comptroller. The
6 voucher shall also be approved by the President of the Senate
7 or the Speaker of the House of Representatives as the case
8 may be.

9 Section 15. The amount of \$20,603,400 or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to meet
11 the ordinary and incidental expenses of the Senate
12 legislative leadership and legislative staff assistants and
13 the House Majority and Minority leadership staff, general
14 staff and office operations. Of this amount, 25.7% is
15 appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
16 expenditures, 25.7% is appropriated to the Senate Minority
17 Leader for such expenditures and 24.8% is appropriated to the
18 Speaker of the House for such expenditures, and 23.8% is
19 appropriated to the House Minority Leader for such
20 expenditures.

21 Section 20. The amount of \$9,382,100, or so much thereof
22 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the

1 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
2 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses of
3 committees, the general staff and operations, per diem
4 employees, special and standing committees, expenses incurred
5 in transcribing and printing of debates. Of this amount,
6 43.018% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for
7 such expenditures and 56.982% is appropriated to the Speaker
8 of the House for such expenditures.

9 Section 25. The amount of \$309,200, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
11 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of
12 Representatives for the ordinary and incidental expenses,
13 also including the purchasing on contract as required by law
14 of printing, binding, printing paper, stationery and office
15 supplies. For the House, no part of which shall be expended
16 for expenses of purchasing, handling or distributing such
17 supplies and against which no indebtedness shall be incurred
18 without the written approval of the Speaker of the House of
19 Representatives. Of this amount, 69.277% is appropriated to
20 the President of the Senate for such expenditures and 30.723%
21 is appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
22 expenditures.

23 Section 30. The amount of \$4,483,050, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
2 President of the Senate for the use of standing committees
3 for expert witnesses, technical services, consulting
4 assistance and other research assistance associated with
5 special studies and long range research projects which may be
6 requested by the standing committees and the Speaker of the
7 House of Representatives for Standing House Committees
8 pursuant to the Legislative Commission Reorganization Act of
9 1984 Of this amount, 46.862% is appropriated to the
10 President of the Senate for such expenditures and 53.138% is
11 appropriated to the Speaker of the House for such
12 expenditures.

13 Section 35. The amount of \$167,000, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
15 President of the Senate and the Senate Minority Leader for
16 allowances for the particular and additional services
17 appertaining to or entailed by the respective officers of the
18 Senate. Of this amount, 50% is appropriated to the President
19 of the Senate for such expenditures and 50% is appropriated
20 to the Senate Minority Leader for such expenditures.

21 Section 40. The amount of \$88,100, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated to the
23 President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of

1 Representatives for travel, including expenses to Springfield
2 of members on official legislative business during weeks when
3 the General Assembly is not in session. Of this amount,
4 65.5% is appropriated to the President of the Senate for such
5 expenditures and 34.5% is appropriated to the Speaker of the
6 House for such expenditures.

7 Section 45. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the
9 General Assembly Operations Revolving Fund to the President
10 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives
11 for to meet ordinary and contingent expenses. Of this
12 amount, 50% is appropriated to the President of the Senate
13 for such expenditures and 50% is appropriated to the Speaker
14 of the House for such expenditures.

15 Section 50. The amount of \$441,600, or so much thereof
16 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an
17 appropriation heretofore made for such purposes in Article 90
18 of Public Act 95-0348 as amended by this Act, is appropriated
19 to the Speaker of the House for expenses in connection with
20 the planning and preparation of redistricting of legislative
21 and representative districts as required by Article IV,
22 Section 3 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970.

1 Section 55. The amount of \$341,600, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
3 Fund to the General Assembly to meet ordinary and contingent
4 expenses. Any use of funds appropriated under this Section
5 must be approved jointly by the Clerk of the House of
6 Representatives and the Secretary of the Senate.

7 Section 60. As used in Section 15 hereof, except where
8 the approval of the Speaker of the House of Representatives
9 is expressively required for the expenditure of or the
10 incurring of indebtedness against an appropriation for
11 certain purchases on contract, "Speaker" means the leader of
12 the party having the largest number of members of the House
13 of Representatives as of January 12, 2008, and "Minority
14 Leader" means the leader of the party having the second
15 largest number of members of the House of Representatives as
16 of January 12, 2008.

17 Section 65. The sum of \$328,900, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Legislative Ethics
19 Commission to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of
20 the Commission and the Office of Legislative Inspector
21 General.
