A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 for the objects and purposes hereinafter named to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the State Employees'
9 Retirement System:

9 Section 10. The sum of \$0, minus the amount transferred
10 to the State Employees' Retirement System pursuant to
11 continuing appropriation authorized by the State Pensions
12 Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the
13 State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the State
14 Employees' Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of
15 Section 8.12 of "An Act in relation to State finance",
16 approved June 10, 1919, as amended.

17 Section 15. The sum of \$51,931,000, or so much thereof
18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
19 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges' Retirement
20 System for the State's Contribution, as provided by law.

21 Section 20. The sum of \$0, minus the amount transferred
22 to the Judges' Retirement System pursuant to continuing

1 appropriation authorized by the State Pensions Fund
2 Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the State
3 Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the Judges'
4 Retirement System pursuant to the provisions of Section 8.12
5 of "An Act in relation to State finance", approved June 10,
6 1919, as amended.

7 Section 25. The sum of \$7,653,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General Assembly
10 Retirement System for the State's Contribution, as provided
11 by law.

12 Section 30. The sum of \$0, minus the amount transferred
13 to the General Assembly Retirement System pursuant to
14 continuing appropriation authorized by the State Pensions
15 Fund Continuing Appropriation Act, is appropriated from the
16 State Pensions Fund to the Board of Trustees of the General
17 Assembly Retirement System, pursuant to the provisions of
18 Section 8.12 of "An Act in relation to State finance",
19 approved June 10, 1919, as amended.

20 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
21 1, 2008.
