2 Section 5. "AN ACT making appropriations", Public Act 95-
3 348, as vetoed, reduced, and restored, is amended by
4 repealing all of Articles 565, 570, 575, 580, 585, 590, 595,
5 600, 605, 610, 615, 620, 625, 630, 635, 640, 645, 650, and
6 655.

7 ARTICLE 2

8 Section 5. In addition to all other amounts appropriated
9 for these purposes, the amount of \$219,964,330 is
10 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Comptroller
11 solely for the purpose of payment of outstanding vouchers as
12 of the effective date of this Act for expenses related to
13 medical assistance under the Illinois Public Aid Code, the
14 Children's Health Insurance Program Act, the Covering ALL
15 KIDS Health Insurance Act, and the Senior Citizens and
16 Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical
17 Assistance Act, but not to exceed the following amounts for
18 classes of providers as follows:
