2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6479, by deleting
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu
4 thereof the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
8 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
9 General Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education to meet
10 ordinary and contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending
11 June 30, 2009:

21 Section 20. The following named sums, or so much thereof
22 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the General

1 Revenue Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for
 2 Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (S.T.E.M.)
 3 diversity initiatives to enhance S.T.E.M. programs for
 4 students from underrepresented groups:

11 Section 25. The sum of \$2,909,000, or so much thereof as
 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 13 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to the
 14 Board of Trustees of the University Center of Lake County for
 15 the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Center.

16 Section 30. The sum of \$21,000,000, or so much thereof
 17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 18 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as
 19 grants authorized by the Health Services Education Grants
 20 Act.

21 Section 40. The sum of \$5,500,000, or so much thereof as
 22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants

1 Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended under
2 the terms and conditions associated with the federal
3 contracts and grants moneys received.

4 Section 45. The sum of \$2,800,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the administration
7 and distribution of grants authorized by the Diversifying
8 Higher Education Faculty in Illinois Program.

9 Section 50. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
11 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as
12 grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of
13 higher education.

14 Section 55. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
16 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for competitive grants
17 for nursing schools to increase the number of graduating
18 nurses.

19 Section 60. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
21 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for nurse educator

1 fellowships to supplement nurse faculty salaries.

2 Section 70. The sum of \$140,700, or so much thereof may
3 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
4 to the Board of Higher Education for costs and expenses
5 related to or in support of a higher education shared
6 services center.

7 Section 75. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for the International
10 Center on Deafness and the Arts (ICODA) Program.

11 Section 80. The following named amounts, or so much
12 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
13 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
14 General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science
15 Academy to meet ordinary and contingent expenses for the
16 fiscal year ending June 30, 2009:

6 Section 85. The following named amounts, or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
8 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
9 Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy Income Fund to the
10 Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy to meet ordinary and
11 contingent expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009:

23 Section 90. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
2 Fund to the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy for the
3 Excellence 2000 Program in Mathematics and Science.

4 Section 100. The sum of \$800,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for grants to
7 the Illinois Education Foundation.

8 Section 110. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
10 Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for the
11 P20/Master Planning program.

12 Section 115. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
14 Fund to the Illinois Board of Higher Education for the Cook
15 County Science/Math program.

16 Section 120. The sum of \$9,500,000, or so much thereof
17 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
18 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as
19 incentive grants to Illinois higher education institutions in
20 the competition for external grants and contracts.
