## "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 55. The following named amounts, or so much 7 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects 8 and purposes named in this Section, are appropriated to the 9 Attorney General to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses 10 of the Attorney General:

1 Section 80. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 3 Fund to the Office of the Attorney General for disbursement 4 to the Illinois Equal Justice Foundation in accordance with 5 the terms of Section 25 of the Illinois Equal Justice Act.

Section 85. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the 7 8 Attorney General from the Married Families Domestic Violence 9 Fund pursuant to Public Act 95-711 for grants to public or private nonprofit agencies for the purposes of facilitating 10 11 or providing free domestic violence leqal advocacy, assistance, or services to married or formerly married 12 victims of domestic violence related to order of protection 13 14 proceedings, or other proceedings for civil remedies for domestic violence. 15

Section 35. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Corrections from the General Revenue Fund for expenses associated with the operation of a pilot community-based diversion program for non-violet female offenders who are mothers.

18 Section 40. The amount of \$12,500,000, or so much 19 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the 20 Department of Corrections from the General Revenue Fund for a 21 grant to Operation Ceasefire to be used in the following 22 locations:

9 Section 50. # ARTICLE 998
