AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 6581, by deleting everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

"ARTICLE 1

AWARDS AND GRANTS 6 7 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated from the Road 8 9 Fund to the Department of Transportation for the objects and 10 purposes hereinafter named: 11 For Transportation Enhancement, Congestion Mitigation, Air Quality, High Priority and 12 Scenic By-way Projects not eligible for 13 inclusion in the Highway Improvement 14

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5 Section 17. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Comprehensive 6 Regional Planning Fund to the Department of Transportation 7 for comprehensive regional planning purposes. 8 Each year's follows: 70% to 9 distribution will be as the Chicago 10 Metropolitan Agency on Planning; 25% to the State's other Metropolitan Planning Organizations (exclusive of CMAP) with 11 each MPO receiving a percentage equal to its area population 12 as it relates to the total population of the areas of all the 13 State's MPOs (exclusive of CMAP); and 5% to the State's Rural 14 15 Planning Agencies with each Agency receiving a percentage equal to its area population as it relates to the total 16 17 population to the area of all the State's Rural Planning Agencies. 18

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AWARDS AND GRANTS

20 Section 65. The sum of \$2,721,300, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Road Fund to the 22 Department of Transportation for reimbursement to 23 participating counties in the County Engineers Compensation 09500HB6581ham001 -3- HDS095 00194 CIN 20194 a Program, providing such reimbursements do not exceed funds to be made available from their federal highway allocations retained by the Department.

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AWARDS AND GRANTS

5 Section 110. The sum of \$3,600,000, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Cycle Rider 7 Safety Training Fund, as authorized by Public Act 82-0649, to 8 the Department of Transportation for reimbursement to State 9 and local universities and colleges for Cycle Rider Safety 10 Training Programs.

Section 180. The Sum of 1,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the I-FLY Fund to the Department of Transportation for grants to the Quincy Regional Airport, the Decatur Airport, and the Williamson Regional Airport, pursuant to the I-FLY Act.

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LUMP SUMS

17 Section 200. The sum of \$119,900, or so much thereof as 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 19 Fund to the Department of Transportation for public 20 transportation technical studies.

AWARDS AND GRANTS

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1 Section 220. The sum of \$342,800, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Transportation for making grants to 3 eligible recipients of funding under Article II of 4 the Downstate Public Transportation Act for the purpose 5 of 6 reimbursing the recipients that provide reduced fares for mass transportation services to students, handicapped persons 7 and the elderly. 8

9 Section 225. The sum of \$37,318,100, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 10 Fund to the Department of Transportation for making grants to 11 the Regional Transportation Authority for the purpose of 12 reimbursing the Service Boards for providing reduced or free 13 fares for transportation services 14 mass to students, 15 handicapped persons, and the elderly.

Section 230. The sum of \$54,251,555, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Transportation making a grant to the Regional Transportation Authority for the funding of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) paratransit services and for other costs and services.

22 Section 240. The sum of \$193,000,000, or so much thereof

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as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public
 Transportation Fund to the Department of Transportation for
 the purpose stated in Section 4.09 of the "Regional
 Transportation Authority Act", as amended.

5 Section 245. The sum of \$40,000,000, or so much thereof may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public 6 as Transportation Fund to the Department of Transportation for 7 making a grant to the Regional Transportation Authority for 8 Additional State Assistance to be used for its purposes as 9 10 provided in the "Regional Transportation Authority Act", but in no event shall this amount exceed the amount provided for 11 12 in Sections 4.09 (c) and 4.09 (d) with respect to Strategic 13 Capital Improvement bonds issued by the Regional Transportation Authority pursuant 14 to the Regional 15 Transportation Authority Act as amended in 1989.

16 Section 250. The sum of \$95,300,000, or so much thereof may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public 17 as Transportation Fund to the Department of Transportation for 18 19 making a grant to the Regional Transportation Authority for 20 Additional Financial Assistance to be used for its purposes as provided in the "Regional Transportation Authority Act", 21 22 but in no event shall this amount exceed the amount provided for in Sections 4.09 (c-5) and 4.09 (d) with respect to 23

Section 255. The following named sums, or so much 4 5 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated from the Downstate Public Transportation Fund to the Department of 6 Transportation for operating assistance grants to provide a 7 portion of the eligible operating expenses for the following 8 carriers for the purposes stated in Article II of Public Act 9 10 78-1109, as amended: Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District12,522,500 11 12 13 Rock Island County Metropolitan 14 15 16 17 18

The sum of \$1,700,000, or so much thereof 16 Section 265. as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Downstate 17 the Transportation Fund to 18 Public Department of 19 Transportation for the purpose stated in Section 6z-17 of the State Finance Act (30ILCS 105/6z-17) and Section 2-2.04 of 20 the Downstate Public Transportation Act (30 ILCS 740/2-2.04), 21 for a grant to Madison County equal to the sales tax 22 transferred from the State and Local Sales Tax Reform Fund. 23
