1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6616

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 6616, by deleting  
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu  
4 thereof the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
7 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
8 Emergency Management Agency for the objects and purposes  
9 hereinafter named:

10 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

11 For costs and services

12 related to ILEAS/MABAS Administration .....125,000

13 Whenever it becomes necessary for the State or any

1 governmental unit to furnish in a disaster area emergency  
 2 services directly related to or required by a disaster and  
 3 existing funds are insufficient to provide such services, the  
 4 Governor may, when he considers such action in the best  
 5 interest of the State, release funds from the General Revenue  
 6 Disaster Relief appropriation in order to provide such  
 7 services or to reimburse local governmental bodies furnishing  
 8 such services. Such appropriation may be used for payment of  
 9 the Illinois National Guard when called to active duty in  
 10 case of disaster, and for the emergency purchase or renting  
 11 of equipment and commodities. Such appropriation shall be  
 12 used for emergency services and relief to the disaster area  
 13 as a whole and shall not be used to provide private relief to  
 14 persons sustaining property damages or personal injury as a  
 15 result of a disaster.

16 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

17 For disaster relief costs incurred  
 18 in current and prior years .....500,000

19 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much  
 20 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
 21 to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the objects  
 22 and purposes hereinafter enumerated:

23 Payable from Radiation Protection Fund:

24 For reimbursing other governmental

1 agencies for their assistance in  
 2 responding to radiological emergencies .....100,000

3 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much  
 4 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
 5 Emergency Management Agency for the objects and purposes  
 6 hereinafter named:

7 Payable from Nuclear Safety Emergency Preparedness Fund:

8 For compensation to local governments  
 9 for expenses attributable to implementation  
 10 and maintenance of plans and programs  
 11 authorized by the Nuclear Safety  
 12 Preparedness Act .....650,000

13 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much  
 14 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
 15 Emergency Management Agency for the objects and purposes  
 16 hereinafter named:

17 Payable from the Federal Aid Disaster Fund:

18 For Federal Disaster Declarations:  
 19 In Current and Prior Years .....50,000,000  
 20 For State administration of the  
 21 Federal Disaster Relief Program .....1,000,000  
 22 Disaster Relief - Hazard Mitigation  
 23 in Current and Prior Years .....40,000,000

1 For State administration of the  
 2 Hazard Mitigation Program .....1,000,000  
 3 Total \$92,000,000

4 Section 25. The following named amounts, or so much  
 5 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Illinois  
 6 Emergency Management Agency for the objects and purposes  
 7 hereinafter named:

8 Payable from the Nuclear Civil Protection Planning Fund:  
 9 For Federal Projects .....500,000  
 10 For Mitigation Assistance .....3,000,000  
 11 Total \$3,500,000

12  
 13 Section 30. The sum of \$561,000, or so much thereof as  
 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation  
 15 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency  
 16 for the purpose of funding costs related to environmental  
 17 cleanup of the Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under  
 18 cooperative agreements with the Federal Government.

19 Section 35. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as  
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation  
 21 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency  
 22 for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and  
 23 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses

1 cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available  
2 surety.

3 ARTICLE 999

4 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect  
5 July 1, 2008."
