625 ILCS 5/12-610.1

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. In the definition of "wireless telephone", includes any device that can be used to send or receive text messages.

1 AN ACT concerning vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 12-610.1 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/12-610.1)
- 7 Sec. 12-610.1. Wireless telephones.
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "wireless telephone" means a
 9 device that is capable of transmitting or receiving telephonic
 10 communications without a wire connecting the device to the
 11 telephone network. "Wireless telephone" includes any device
- that can be used to send or receive text messages.
 - (b) A person under the age of 19 years who holds an instruction permit issued under Section 6-105 or 6-107.1, or a person under the age of 19 years who holds a graduated license issued under Section 6-107, may not drive a vehicle on a roadway while using a wireless phone.
 - (c) This Section does not apply to a person under the age of 19 years using a wireless telephone for emergency purposes, including, but not limited to, an emergency call to a law enforcement agency, health care provider, fire department, or other emergency services agency or entity.
- 23 (d) If a graduated driver's license holder over the age of

- 18 committed an offense against traffic regulations governing 1 2 the movement of vehicles or any violation of Section 6-107 or 3 Section 12-603.1 of this Code in the 6 months prior to the graduated driver's license holder's 18th birthday, and was 4 5 subsequently convicted of the violation, the provisions of 6 paragraph (b) shall continue to apply until such time as a 7 period of 6 consecutive months has elapsed without an additional violation and subsequent conviction of an offense 8 9 against traffic regulations governing the movement of vehicles 10 or any violation of Section 6-107 or Section 12-603.1 of this 11 Code.
