HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

2	WHEREAS, The Monetary Award Program, also known as "MAP",
3	which is administered by the Illinois Student Assistance
4	Commission, is among the premiere state-funded, need-based,
5	postsecondary grant programs in the United States; and

- WHEREAS, MAP grants are intended to provide funding for all Illinois students seeking postsecondary degrees who demonstrate financial need, providing \$347 million in grants to 146,853 students in 2006; and
- WHEREAS, The profile of students attending Illinois colleges and universities has undergone dramatic changes in the past decade, as increasing numbers of students are older, married, parents, or working; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Those students defined as independent, meaning 15 those who are 24 years of age or older, those who are married, 16 those with dependents, and those who have been in the military, 17 are often the most financially challenged in their endeavors to 18 pursue a postsecondary education; and
- 19 WHEREAS, As more working adults seek to return to school, 20 they face a federal financial aid system designed primarily for 21 traditional students; and

- 1 WHEREAS, Low-income working adults are often expected to 2 contribute an unrealistic proportion of their income to college 3 costs; therefore, be it
- HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 4 ΒY THE ΟF THE 5 NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that the Illinois Student Assistance 6 Commission, in cooperation with the Board of Higher Education, 7 8 Women Employed, the Federation of Independent Illinois 9 Colleges & Universities, and other concerned parties, document 10 the overall financial need of independent students in Illinois 11 and the degree to which they are served by the Monetary Award Program in a report to be delivered to the General Assembly no 12 later than December 31, 2007; and be it further 13
- 14 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be 15 delivered to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission.
