- 5 WHEREAS, He was born May 14, 1930, in Ripon, Wisconsin; his 6 parents were Kenneth C. and Frieda H. Rusch Page; he married 7 Mary Ellen Ward on Nov. 24, 1955, in Chicago; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Mr. Page graduated from Tolono High School; he 9 graduated from the University of Illinois in 1952 with a 10 Bachelor's degree in speech education and in 1955 with a 11 Master's degree in education; and
- WHEREAS, He served in the United States Army during the
  Korean War from 1952 to 1954 and was stationed in Japan; he was
  a theater and speech teacher at Edison Junior High School from
  1955 to 1969; Mr. Page taught English, theater, and radio-TV at
  Champaign Centennial High School from 1969 to 1991 and helped
  design the Centennial Auditorium Theater; and
- WHEREAS, He was the host of the "Marshall Magic Show" at WCIA-TV and the host of the educational science show, "What's New," at WILL-TV; he was a weatherman at WICD for 41 years; as a film producer, he worked on the United Way documentary

- 2 his work on the documentary about the Grand Canyon, which aired
- on WICD; Mr. Page was a magician for most of his life; and he
- 4 was a member of Our Lady of the Lake Catholic Church in

- 7 Ellen; his sons, Mark Allan Page, Ward C. Page, John William
