2 Illinois WHEREAS, The members of the House of 3 Representatives are pleased to honor the Puerto Rican Parade 4 Committee of Chicago for the outstanding work it has performed 5 for the Puerto Rican community in the City of Chicago for over 6 40 years; and

WHEREAS, The mission of La Casa Puertorriquena, which translates to The Puerto Rican House, is to make the house a home to Humboldt Park and other Latino communities in Chicago and to establish the Puerto Rican Parade Committee of Chicago as a voice for Puerto Ricans, instilling community empowerment, and encouraging Puerto Ricans to positively represent and preserve their cultural roots, not only in Chicago but throughout the Midwest; and
