WHEREAS, The first congregation of the Galena United Methodist Church was organized in 1829 and consisted of only six members; the congregation held services in a house on Bench Street in Galena until 1832, when the members construction of a new church; the first church burned to the ground in January 1838 and was immediately replaced with a new stone and brick building, which was dedicated in 1841; the first parsonage still remains on the hillside of the church's lot and is known as the Osprey's Nest; the church's current building was built in 1856 and was dedicated in January 1857; and

WHEREAS, The Galena United Methodist Church contains many beautiful stained glass windows and a Moline Pipe Organ, which were installed in 1868; and

WHEREAS, The Galena United Methodist Church has served as a house of worship for such famous people as Ulysses S. Grant, who attended the church with his family, and the Reverend John
