1 HOUSE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, Pioneer broadcaster Richard Durham was born in 2 3 Mississippi and raised in Chicago; and WHEREAS, Richard Durham began his legendary broadcast 4 5 career during the Great Depression with the Writer's Project of the Works Progress Administration; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Richard Durham later wrote for the CBS affiliate 8 WBBM Chicago; and 9 WHEREAS, As the sole writer and producer of Destination Freedom, Richard Durham's goal was to combat the negative 10 11 stereotypes of blacks in the media; and 12 WHEREAS, Destination Freedom was originally heard on WMAQ 13 Radio from June 27, 1948 to August, 1950; it was sponsored initially by the Chicago Defender, then by the Chicago Urban 14 League; and 15 The groundbreaking radio drama Destination 16 WHEREAS, 17 Freedom included 91 episodes, showcasing the lives of prominent black Americans; and 18
