HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Due to their Japanese lineage, many patriotic Americans were treated as enemies after the bombing of Pearl Harbor in 1941; these Americans, known as "Nisei", or second generation Japanese Americans, fought to prove their loyalties to this nation by entering the United States Army, numbering in the thousands in a stunning example of bravery and patriotism; and

WHEREAS, The bravery and determination of the thousands of Nisei is well-documented, with such units as the 100th / 442nd Regimental Combat Team, one of the most awarded and acclaimed units in American history, and the Military Intelligence Service, which saved innumerable lives using their knowledge of Japanese language and culture to bring a swift end to World War II in the Pacific theater; and

WHEREAS, The incredible acts of sacrifice and valor exhibited by these men are worthy of the greatest respect and admiration and must not be forgotten by subsequent generations; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NINETY-FIFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we urge the Citizens Stamp Advisory Committee and the United
