- WHEREAS, Significant achievements while Mr. Hill served as
 Director include the initiation of the Annual Festival of
 Lights in Zion, the renovation of Port Shiloh Swimming Pool,
 the initiation and guiding of the vision, planning, and
 acquisition of the site, construction, and operation of
 Shepherd's Crook Golf Course, the installation of the

- 10 Board, and a member of the Illinois Park & Recreation
- 11 Association and the National Recreation & Park Association; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Hill plans to spend his retirement traveling,
- including a special trip to Southeast Asia; he also plans to
- spend time with his grandchildren and family; therefore, be it
