J. 20 Hooper Elementary School in Lindenhurst; he acquired his 21 22 Educational Specialist degree from Northeastern Illinois

- 12 WHEREAS, Matt Tabar has provided change for the district, 13 including new additions to the school and promoting two 14 successful referenda; he has witnessed growth in the district 15 and has touched the lives of many children in the last eighteen 16 years; therefore, be it
