WHEREAS, Specialist Penrod received the Bronze Star, Purple Heart, Army Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, Combat Infantryman Badge, and M16 Award Expert Rifle Badge for his brave service; and
