1 HOUSE RESOLUTION Bullying is 2 WHEREAS, physical, verbal, sexual, 3 emotional harm or intimidation directed at a person or group of 4 people; and WHEREAS, Bullying occurs in neighborhoods, playgrounds, 5 schools, and through technology, such as the Internet; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Various researchers have concluded that bullying 8 is the most common form of violence, affecting millions of 9 American children and adolescents annually; and WHEREAS, Thousands of Illinois children and adolescents 10 11 are targets of bullying annually; and 12 WHEREAS, Targets of bullying are more likely to acquire physical, emotional, and learning problems and students who are 13 repeatedly bullied often fear such activities as riding the 14 bus, going to school, and attending community activities; and 15 16 WHEREAS, Children who bully are at greater risk of engaging 17 in more serious violent behaviors; and 18 WHEREAS, A large percentage of children who are bullied 19 believe that adult help is infrequent and ineffective;

- 5 Prevention Awareness Week in the State of Illinois; and be it

- 8 recreation programs, religious institutions, and community
- 9 organizations to engage in a variety of awareness and
- 10 prevention activities designed to make our communities safer
- for all children and adolescents.
