7 WHEREAS, He was assigned to 610th Engineer Support Company, 14th Engineer Battalion, 555th Engineer Brigade; the company 8 9 deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom in March of 10 2008; Private Gulczynski initially entered military service on 11 June 7, 2007; after completing advanced individual training in his military occupational specialty of 21E: Heavy Construction 12 Equipment Operator at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, he reported 13 14 to Fort Lewis on November 21, 2007; and

15 WHEREAS, His civilian education includes his graduation 16 from Spring Trail Elementary School in Carol Stream, Eastview 17 Middle School, and Bartlett High School in 2007; his military 18 awards and decorations include the National Defense Service 19 Medal and the Army Service Ribbon; and
