SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-41010

Amends the Counties Code. Provides that the county board in any county (instead of a county with a population of less then 3,000,000) may establish a code hearing unit. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 41010 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/5-41010)
- 7 Sec. 5-41010. Code hearing unit. The county board in any
- 8 county having a population of less than 3,000,000 inhabitants
- 9 may establish by ordinance a code hearing unit within an
- 10 existing code enforcement agency or as a separate and
- independent agency in county government. A county may establish
- 12 a code hearing unit and administrative adjudication process
- only under the provisions of this Division 5-41. The function
- of the code hearing unit shall be to expedite the prosecution
- and correction of code violations as provided in this Division
- 16 5-41.
