SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-600

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-600

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the Secretary of State shall not issue a series of special plates unless applications have been received for 3,333 (rather than 10,000) plates of that series. Deletes language providing that the Secretary may prescribe a different number of required applications. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing

 Section 3-600 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-600) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-600)
- 7 Sec. 3-600. Requirements for issuance of special plates.
- 8 (a) The Secretary of State shall not issue a series of
 9 special plates unless applications, as prescribed by the
 10 Secretary, have been received for 3,333 10,000 plates of that
- 11 series; except that the Secretary of State may prescribe some
- 12 other required number of applications if that number is
- 13 sufficient to pay for the total cost of designing,
- 14 manufacturing and issuing the special license plate.
- 15 (b) The Secretary of State, upon issuing a new series of 16 special license plates, shall notify all law enforcement 17 officials of the design, color and other special features of
- 18 the special license plate series.
- 19 (c) This Section shall not apply to special license plate
- 20 categories in existence on the effective date of this
- 21 amendatory Act of 1990, or to the Secretary of State's
- discretion as established in Section 3-611.
