Amends the Illinois Bank Holding Company Act of 1957. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning restrictions on bank holding companies.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Bank Holding Company Act of 1957 is amended by changing Section 3.07 as follows:
- 6 (205 ILCS 10/3.07) (from Ch. 17, par. 2510)
- Sec. 3.07. Except as authorized under Section 3.061 of this 7 Act, no bank holding company other than an an Illinois bank 8 9 holding company, may control any Illinois bank or own more than 10 5% of the voting shares of any Illinois bank, unless: (a) such bank holding company acquired such control or voting shares 11 12 under circumstances described in (A), (B), (C), (D) or (E) of subsection (h) of Section 2 of this Act; or (b) such bank 13 14 holding company qualifies under the provisions of Section
