1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 620

AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 620, AS AMENDED, 2 3 with reference to page and lines numbers of House Amendment No. 4 2, on page 10, by replacing lines 3 through 14 with the 5 following: "(o) A water utility, municipality, or non-profit water 6 system that receives notice that a fire hydrant is inoperable 7 shall be required to report the situation to the unit of local 8 9 government on an annual basis and fire department or fire district within 2 hours of receiving notice, and shall be 10 required to make repairs within 2 days. A water utility, 11 12 municipality, or non-profit water system that fails to notify the fire department or fire district within 2 hours after 13 14 receiving notice that a fire hydrant is broken shall be fined 15 \$100 per day to be paid to the fire department or fire district. The penalty shall be waived if a delay in the repair 16
