8	Sec. 2310-361. The Lung Cancer Research Fund. The Lung
9	Cancer Research Fund is created as a special fund in the State
10	treasury. From appropriations to the Department from the Fund,
11	the Department shall make grants to public or private
	not-for-profit entities for the purpose of lung cancer
12	not for profit entitles for the purpose of fung cancer

- 3 Section 15. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by
- 4 adding Section 50700 and by changing Sections 509 and 510 as

- 7 Sec. 50700. The lung cancer research checkoff. For taxable
- 8 years ending on or after December 31, 2007, the Department
- 9 shall print, on its standard individual income tax form, a
- 10 provision indicating that, if the taxpayer wishes to contribute
- 11 to the Lung Cancer Research Fund, as authorized by this
- amendatory Act of the 95th General Assembly, then he or she may
- do so by stating the amount of the contribution (not less than
- 14 \$1) on the return and indicating that the contribution will
- reduce the taxpayer's refund or increase the amount of payment
- 16 to accompany the return. The taxpayer's failure to remit any
- 17 amount of the increased payment reduces the contribution
- accordingly. This Section does not apply to any amended return.

- Sec. 509. Tax checkoff explanations. All individual income
- 21 tax return forms shall contain appropriate explanations and

the funds to which contributions may be made under this Article 5. following funds: the Child Abuse Prevention Fund, the Illinois Wildlife Preservation Fund (as required by the Illinois Non-Game Wildlife Protection Act), the Alzheimer's Disease Research Fund (as required by the Alzheimer's Disease Research Act), the Assistance to the Homeless Fund (as required by this Act), the Penny Severns Breast and Cervical Cancer Research Fund, the National World War II Memorial Fund, the Prostate Cancer Research Fund, the Lou Gehrig's Disease (ALS) Research Fund, the Multiple Sclerosis Assistance Fund, the Sarcoidosis Research Fund, the Leukemia Treatment and Education Fund, the World War II Illinois Veterans Memorial Fund, the Korean War Veterans National Museum and Library Fund, the Illinois Military Family Relief Fund, the Blindness Prevention Fund, the Illinois Veterans' Homes Fund, the Epilepsy Treatment and Education Grants in Aid Fund, the Diabetes Research Checkoff Fund, the Vince Demuzio Memorial Colon Cancer Fund, the Autism Research Fund, the Heartsaver AED Fund, the Asthma and Lung Research Fund, and the Illinois Brain Tumor Research Fund.

Each form shall contain a statement that the contributions will reduce the taxpayer's refund or increase the amount of payment to accompany the return. Failure to remit any amount of increased payment shall reduce the contribution accordingly.

If, on October 1 of any year, the total contributions to any one of the funds made under this <u>Article 5</u> Section do not

- 1 equal \$100,000 or more, the explanations and spaces for
- 2 designating contributions to the fund shall be removed from the
- 3 individual income tax return forms for the following and all
- 4 subsequent years and all subsequent contributions to the fund
- 5 shall be refunded to the taxpayer.
