1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1130

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1130, AS AMENDED,
3 replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The sum of \$205,475, or so much of this
6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
7 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for
8 replacement of water and sewer service to various buildings
9 at the Illinois State Fairgrounds, Springfield.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$311,815, or so much of this
11 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
12 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for an
13 airlock addition to Metrology (Weights & Measures) Lab at the
14 Illinois State Fairgrounds, Springfield.

1 Section 15. The sum of \$104,000, or so much of this
2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
3 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to upgrade
4 the snow melt system at the Attorney General Building,
5 Springfield.

6 Section 20. The sum of \$2,600,000, or so much of this
7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
8 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to upgrade
9 HVAC and domestic water system at the Michael A. Bilandic
10 Building, Chicago.

11 Section 25. The sum of \$57,066, or so much of this amount
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
13 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for
14 emergency cooling tower replacement at the Springfield
15 Regional Office Building, 4500 S. Sixth Street Road,
16 Springfield.

17 Section 30. The sum of \$805,900, or so much of this
18 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
19 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to renovate
20 for office space the Suburban North Regional Office Facility,
21 Des Plaines.

1 Section 35. The sum of \$244,788, or so much of this
2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
3 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to repair
4 and replace roofing systems at Dwight Correctional Center.

5 Section 40. The sum of \$118,929, or so much of this
6 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
7 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to replace
8 roofing systems at Sheridan Correctional Center.

9 Section 45. The sum of \$577,757, or so much of this
10 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
11 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to replace
12 roofing systems at Vandalia Correctional Center.

13 Section 50. The sum of \$663,720, or so much of this
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
15 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for
16 emergency roof replacement on various buildings at Vienna
17 Correctional Center.

18 Section 55. The sum of \$1,402,428, or so much of this
19 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
20 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for

1 Effingham District 12 Firing Range, State Police.

2 Section 60. The sum of \$278,491, or so much of this
3 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
4 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to renovate
5 a retaining wall and two shelters at Black Hawk State
6 Historic Site, Rock Island.

7 Section 65. The sum of \$215,627, or so much of this
8 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
9 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to create a
10 new entrance around existing bronze artwork doors at Cahokia
11 Mounds State Historic Site, Collinsville.

12 Section 70. The sum of \$275,496, or so much of this
13 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
14 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to upgrade
15 a high voltage monitoring system at the State Capitol
16 complex, Springfield.

17 Section 75. The sum of \$1,070,000, or so much of this
18 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
19 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to upgrade
20 electrical systems at Driver Services Facilities, North,
21 South and West, Chicago.

1 Section 80. The sum of \$252,782, or so much of this
2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
3 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for
4 renovation and improvement of pedestrian traffic flow at
5 Chicago West Driver Services Facility.

6 Section 85. The sum of \$2,300,000, or so much of this
7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
8 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to replace
9 a chimney stack and ash handling system at Quincy Veterans'
10 Home.

11 Section 90. The sum of \$9,207, or so much of this amount
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
13 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for design
14 services to replace a septic system at Buffalo Rock State
15 Park, LaSalle County.

16 Section 95. The sum of \$400,000, or so much of this
17 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
18 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to replace
19 yellow-head marshy dam culverts at Moraine Hills State Park,
20 McHenry County.

1 Section 100. The sum of \$63,279, or so much of this
2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
3 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for design
4 services to replace a lodge pool dehumidifier at Pere
5 Marquette State Park, Jersey County.

6 Section 105. The sum of \$621,000, or so much of this
7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
8 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for
9 emergency replacement of a sewage treatment plant at Pere
10 Marquette State Park, Jersey County.

11 Section 110. The sum of \$550,000, or so much of this
12 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
13 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to replace
14 Cox Bridge at Carlyle State Fish & Wildlife Area, Fayette
15 County.

16 Section 115. The sum of \$44,584, or so much of this
17 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
18 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for design
19 services to replace dump and fish cleaning stations at
20 Stephen A. Forbes State Park, Marion County.

21 Section 120. The sum of \$3,100,000, or so much of this

1 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
2 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to
3 rehabilitate the interior and exterior at Dana-Thomas House
4 State Historic Site, Springfield.

5 Section 125. The sum of \$9,170, or so much of this amount
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
7 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for design
8 services for emergency roof repairs at David Davis Mansion
9 State Historic Site, Bloomington.

10 Section 130. The sum of \$280,000, or so much of this
11 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
12 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to replace
13 a sewer system at Lincoln Log Cabin State Historic Site,
14 Coles County.

15 Section 135. The sum of \$54,886, or so much of this
16 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
17 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for design
18 services to replace a domestic hot water heater at Illinois
19 River Correctional Center, Canton.

20 Section 140. The sum of \$27,195, or so much of this
21 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital

1 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for design
2 services to replace operators and main gates at Taylorville
3 Correctional Center.

4 Section 145. The sum of \$350,000, or so much of this
5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
6 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to upgrade
7 a sewage treatment plant at Hardin County Work Camp.

8 Section 150. The sum of \$68,241, or so much of this
9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
10 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for design
11 services for emergency parapet wall repairs at Kenneth Hall
12 Regional Office Building, East St. Louis.

13 Section 155. The sum of \$3,150,000, or so much of this
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
15 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for Medical
16 Center (Edwards Center), Chicago.

17 Section 160. The sum of \$64,160, or so much of this
18 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
19 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for design
20 services to renovate Unit J-East for forensic use at Chicago-
21 Read Mental Health Center.

1 Section 165. The sum of \$171,572, or so much of this
2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
3 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for design
4 services to convert Read Building for office space at Elgin
5 Mental Health Center.

6 Section 170. The sum of \$25,200, or so much of this
7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
8 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for
9 emergency roof repairs at Lincoln-Herndon Law Offices State
10 Historic Site, Springfield.

11 Section 175. The sum of \$6,650,000, or so much of this
12 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
13 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to upgrade
14 a power plant at Logan Correctional Center, Lincoln.

15 Section 180. The sum of \$453,000, or so much of this
16 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
17 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to upgrade
18 a sewage treatment plant at Centralia Correctional Center.

19 Section 185. The sum of \$372,000, or so much of this
20 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital

1 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to replace
 2 an emergency generator at Collinsville Regional Office
 3 Complex.

4 Section 190. The sum of \$250,000, or so much of this
 5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
 6 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board for
 7 emergency roof and interior and exterior repairs at Ullin
 8 District 22, State Police.

9 Section 195. The sum of \$2,180,000, or so much of this
 10 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital
 11 Development Fund to the Capital Development Board to upgrade
 12 a firing range at DuQuoin District 13, State Police.

13 Section 200. The following named amounts, or so much
 14 thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated from the
 15 Capital Development Bond Fund to the Capital Development
 16 Board for the following purposes:
