- 3 line 12, after the period, by inserting the following:
- 4 "The Authority may contract with another public or private

- 9 "As used in this subsection (a-5), "vehicle" includes any
- 10 <u>vehicle as defined in Section 1-217 of the Illinois Vehicle</u>

- by replacing lines 6 through 26 on page 12 and lines 1 through
- 4 on page 13 with the following:
- 14 "contrary. If a Department of State Police Officer or local law
- 15 enforcement officer having jurisdiction observes that a cover
- or other device or material or substance is obstructing the

visibility or electronic image recording of the plate, the 1 officer shall issue a Uniform Traffic Citation and shall 2 confiscate the cover or other device that obstructs the 3 4 visibility or electronic image recording of the plate. If the 5 Department of State Police Officer or local law enforcement officer having jurisdiction observes that the plate itself has 6 been physically treated with a substance or material that is 7 obstructing the visibility or electronic image recording of the 8 9 plate, the officer shall issue a Uniform Traffic Citation and 10 shall confiscate the plate. A fine of \$75 shall be imposed in any instance where a plate cover obstructs the visibility or 11 electronic image recording of the plate. A fine of \$1,000 shall 12 13 be imposed where a plate has been physically altered with any 14 chemical or reflective substance or coating that obstructs the 15 visibility or electronic image recording of the plate. The Secretary of State shall revoke the registration of any plate 16 that has been found by a court or administrative tribunal to 17 have been physically altered with any chemical or reflective 18 substance or coating that obstructs the visibility or 19 20 electronic image recording of the plate Clear plastic covers 21 are permissible as long as they remain clear and do not 22 obstruct the visibility of the plates.
