2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Consumer Installment Loan Act is amended by
changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (205 ILCS 670/1) (from Ch. 17, par. 5401)

7 Sec. 1. License required to engage in business. No person, 8 partnership, association, limited liability company, or 9 corporation shall engage in the the business of making loans of 10 money in a principal amount not exceeding \$25,000, and charge, contract for, or receive on any such loan a greater rate of 11 interest, discount, or consideration therefor than the lender 12 would be permitted by law to charge if he were not a licensee 13 14 hereunder, except as authorized by this Act after first obtaining a license from the Director of Financial Institutions 15 16 (hereinafter called the Director).
