

## 95TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2007 and 2008 SB1245

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1705/4.3

from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 100-4.3

Amends the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Administrative Act. Provides that the Department of Human Services shall establish a system of regular and ongoing on-site inspections of each facility under its jurisdiction including surveillance procedures designed to identify and prevent abuse and neglect. Provides that the surveillance procedures must include, but not be limited to, the use of security cameras and the use of persons to perform covert investigations of the daily operation of the facility.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
- 5 Disabilities Administrative Act is amended by changing Section
- 6 4.3 as follows:

- 8 Sec. 4.3. Site visits and inspections.
- 9 (a) (Blank).
- 10 (b) The Department shall establish a system of  $\underline{\text{regular and}}$
- 11 <u>ongoing annual</u> on-site inspections of each facility under its
- 12 jurisdiction <u>including surveillance procedures designed to</u>
- identify and prevent abuse and neglect. The surveillance
- 14 procedures must include, but not be limited to, the use of
- 15 <u>security cameras and the use of persons to perform covert</u>
- 16 <u>investigations of the daily operation of the facility</u>. The
- inspections shall be conducted by the Department's central
- 18 office to:
- 19 (1) Determine facility compliance with Department
- 20 policies and procedures;
- 21 (2) Determine facility compliance with audit
- 22 recommendations;
- 23 (3) Evaluate facility compliance with applicable

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- (4) Review and follow up on complaints made by community mental health agencies and advocates, and on findings of the Human Rights Authority division of the Guardianship and Advocacy Commission; and
- 6 (5) Review administrative and management problems
  7 identified by other sources.
