Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

5	Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof
6	as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
7	General Revenue Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy
8	Commission for the purposes hereinafter named:

- Section 10. The sum of \$187,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Guardianship and Advocacy Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy Commission for services pursuant to Section 5 of the Guardianship and Advocacy Act.
- Section 15. The sum of \$279,000, or so much thereof as
 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 Fund to the Guardianship and Advocacy Commission for costs
 and expenses related to or in support of a Social Services
 shared services center.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2007.
