Section 15. The sum of \$74,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground 11 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois 12 Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call 13 Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground 14 15 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act.

Section 20. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may 16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Utility 17 Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce 18 19 Commission for refunds.

20 Section 25. The sum of \$45,900,000, or so much thereof 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless as Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission 22

1 for grants to emergency telephone system boards, qualified government entities, or the Department of State Police for 2 the implementation, operation, 3 desiqn, maintenance, or upgrade of wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency services and 4 public safety answering points and for reimbursement of the 5 6 Communications Revolving Fund for administrative costs incurred by the Illinois Commerce Commission related to 7 administering the program. 8

9 Section 30. The sum of \$19,500,000, or so much thereof 10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless Fund to 11 Carrier Reimbursement the Illinois Commerce Commission for reimbursement of wireless carriers for costs 12 incurred in complying with the applicable provisions of 13 Federal Communications Commission wireless enhanced 9-1-1 14 15 services mandates and for reimbursement of the Communications Revolving Fund for administrative costs incurred by the 16 17 Illinois Commerce Commission related to administering the 18 program.

19 Section 35. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Digital Divide 21 Elimination Infrastructure Fund to the Illinois Commerce 22 Commission for grants and awards for the construction of 23 high-speed data transmission facilities.

Section 50. The sum of \$7,000,000, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 7 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for 8 disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance 9 10 Registration Program to be distributed to: (1) participating states, provided that no distributions exceed funds made 11 available from registration collections; (2) for refunds for 12 overpayments; and (3) for administrative expenses. 13

14 Section 55. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 16 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for 17 railroad crossing improvement initiatives.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,2007.
