1 AN ACT concerning public aid.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 5-5.26 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-5.26 new)
- Sec. 5-5.26. Cost-reporting mechanism for child and adult psychiatric services.
- 9 (a) The General Assembly finds that direct access to psychiatric mental health services for children and adults 10 suffering from mental illness will improve the quality of life 11 for these individuals and will reduce health care costs by 12 avoiding the need for more costly inpatient hospitalization. 13 14 Thus, it is the intent of the General Assembly to develop policy aimed at ensuring that psychiatrists providing child and 15 adult psychiatric services on an outpatient basis are 16 17 adequately reimbursed for the cost of providing these services. Therefore, in order to determine the actual costs, the 18 Department of Healthcare and Family Services shall develop a 19 cost-reporting mechanism for service providers as defined in 20 21 this Section by no later than January 1, 2009. The Department 22 of Healthcare and Family Services shall consult with service providers as defined in this Section to assist with the 2.3

development of the cost-reporting mechanism. By no later tha
March 1, 2009, the Department of Healthcare and Family Service
shall report to the Governor and the General Assembly on th
results of the cost-reporting mechanism. This report shal
include, but need not be limited to, details on the developmen
of the cost-reporting mechanism and its accurate reflection of
the actual costs to service providers for providing child an
adult psychiatric services. The Department of Healthcare an
Family Services shall, subject to appropriation, establish
separate cost-based reimbursement rate based on th
cost-reporting mechanism for psychiatrists who provide chil
and adult psychiatric services on an outpatient basis fo
service providers as defined by this Section.

- (b) This Section applies only to psychiatrists who provide child and adult psychiatric services on an outpatient basis for service providers as defined in this Section.
- (c) For purposes of this Section:
  - "Cost-based reimbursement rate" means a rate of reimbursement equal to the allowable and audited reasonable costs reported.
- "Psychiatrist" means a psychiatrist as defined in Section 1-121 of the Mental Health and Developmental Disabilities Code.
- "Service provider" means any of the following that demonstrates a combined Medicaid, poverty, and uninsured patient population penetration rate of 60% or greater:
- (1) An entity certified by the Illinois Department of
