1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2474

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2474 on page 3, 3 immediately below line 8, by inserting the following:

"(e) Notwithstanding any other rulemaking authority that may exist, neither the Governor nor any agency or agency head under the jurisdiction of the Governor has any authority to make or promulgate rules to implement or enforce the provisions of this Act. If, however, the Governor believes that rules are necessary to implement or enforce the provisions of this Act, the Governor may suggest rules to the General Assembly by filing them with the Clerk of the House and the Secretary of the Senate and by requesting that the General Assembly authorize such rulemaking by law, enact those suggested rules into law, or take any other appropriate action in the General Assembly's discretion. Nothing contained in this Act shall be interpreted to grant rulemaking authority under any other Illinois statute where such authority is not otherwise explicitly given. For the purposes of this paragraph, "rules"

- are given the meanings contained in Sections 1-20 and 1-25 of 3

- 7 on page 4, immediately below line 19, by inserting the
