The sum of \$362,192, or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 15 16 business on June 30, 2008, from appropriations heretofore made for such purpose in Article 235, Sections 20 and 25 of 17 Public Act 95-348, is reappropriated from the Illinois 18 19 Historic Sites Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for awards and grants for historic preservation programs made 20 either independently or in cooperation with the Federal 21 Government or any agency thereof, any municipal corporation, 22 or political subdivision of the State, or with any public or 23

- Section 85. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Historic Preservation Agency for a grant to the Illinois Abraham Lincoln Bicentennial Commission for expenses and activities related to promoting knowledge and understanding of the life and times of Abraham Lincoln and observances commemorating Abraham Lincoln's birthday on February 12, 2009.
- 9 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 10 1, 2008.
