9 Section 15. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground 11 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois 12 Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call 13 Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground 14 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act.

Section 20. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may he necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for refunds.

19 Section 25. The sum of \$56,600,000, or so much thereof 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless 21 Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission 22 for grants to emergency telephone system boards, qualified 1 government entities, or the Department of State Police for 2 the design, implementation, operation, maintenance, or 3 upgrade of wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency services and 4 public safety answering points.

5 Section 30. The sum of \$12,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless 6 Carrier Reimbursement Fund to the Illinois 7 Commerce Commission for reimbursement of wireless carriers for costs 8 9 incurred in complying with the applicable provisions of 10 Federal Communications Commission wireless enhanced 9-1-1 services mandates and for administrative costs incurred by 11 the Illinois Commerce Commission related to administering the 12 program. 13

14 Section 40. The amount of \$3,591,709, or so much thereof 15 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 16 business on June 30, 2008, from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 195, Section 40 of Public 17 95-348, is reappropriated from the Digital Divide 18 Act 19 Elimination Infrastructure Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for grants and awards for the construction of 20 high-speed data transmission facilities. 21

20 Section 50. The sum of \$7,000,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 22 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1) 23 disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance 24 Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration SB2962 -6- OMB095 00342 JMB 20342 b 1 System; (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for 2 administrative expenses.

3 Section 55. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 5 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for 6 railroad crossing improvement initiatives.

7 Section 60. The sum of \$2,090,800, or so much thereof as 8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 9 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for the 10 costs associated with the implementation of Senate Bill 435, 11 the Illinois Commercial Safety Towing Law. This section is 12 operative only if Senate Bill 435 of the 95th General Assembly 13 becomes law.

Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July1, 2008.
