Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

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1 Section 10. The sum of \$000, or so much thereof as may 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 3 to the Department of Military Affairs for a Lincoln's 4 Challenge satellite campus which must be no closer than a 100 5 mile radius from the existing program.

Section 15. The sum of \$11,500,000, or so much thereof 6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support 7 8 Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military 9 Affairs Facilities Division for expenses related to Army National Guard Facilities operations and maintenance 10 as provided for in the Cooperative Funding Agreements, including 11 12 costs in prior years.

13 Section 20. The sum of \$415,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support 14 15 Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Facilities Division for expenses related to 16 the and Kankakee armories for and 17 Bartonville operations 18 maintenance according to the Joint-Use Agreement, including costs in prior years. 19

20 Section 25. The sum of \$43,000, or so much thereof as 21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

4 Section 30. The sum of \$7,400, or so much thereof as may 5 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 6 to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant 7 General Division for expenses related to the care and 8 preservation of historic artifacts.

9 Section 35. The sum of \$1,432,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Military Affairs 11 Trust Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Office of 12 the Adjutant General Division to support youth and other 13 programs, provided such amounts shall not exceed funds to be 14 made available from public or private sources.

15 Section 40. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military 16 Family Relief Fund to the Department of Military Affairs 17 18 Office of the Adjutant General Division for the issuance of grants to persons or families of persons who are members of 19 the Illinois National Guard or Illinois residents who are 20 members of the armed forces of the United States and who have 21 22 been called to active duty as a result of the September 11,

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2 Section 45. The sum of \$000, or so much thereof as may 3 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 4 to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant 5 General Division for costs and expenses related to or in 6 support of a public safety shared services center.

7 Section 50. No contract shall be entered into or 8 obligation incurred for any expenditures made from an 9 appropriation herein made in Section 25 until after the 10 purpose and amounts have been approved in writing by the 11 Governor.

Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July1, 2008.
