Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of

22	issues appeals cases to which the agency is appointed:

- 1 Section 20. The following named amount of \$3,080,099, or 2 so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital Litigation Trust Fund to the Office of the State 3 Defender for expenses incurred in 4 5 assistance to trial attorneys under item (c) (5) of Section 10 of the State Appellate Defender Act. 6
- Section 25. The following named amount, \$250,200, or so 7 8 much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of 9 the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary and contingent 10 11 expenses of the Expungement Program.
- Section 30. The following named amount, \$20,000, or so 12 13 much thereof as may be necessary, respectively, appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of 14 15 the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide training to Public Defenders under the Public Defender Training Program. 16
- 17 Section 35. The following named amount, \$350,000, or so necessary, respectively, 18 much thereof be as may is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of 19 20 the State Appellate Defender to develop a Juvenile Defender 21 Resource Center.

- 1 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
