SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/2A-3 from Ch. 46, par. 2A-3 10 ILCS 5/25-8 from Ch. 46, par. 25-8

Amends the Election Code. Provides that a vacancy in the office of U.S. Senator shall be filled at a special election, rather than by temporary gubernatorial appointment, when the vacancy occurs more than one year before the next general election. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Sections 2A-3 and 25-8 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/2A-3) (from Ch. 46, par. 2A-3)
- 7 Sec. 2A-3. United States Senator Time of Election. A
- 8 United States Senator shall be elected at the general election
- 9 immediately preceding the expiration of the term of an
- 10 incumbent United States Senator from this State. A vacancy in
- 11 the office of United States Senator shall be filled as provided
- 12 in Section 25-8.

- 14 (10 ILCS 5/25-8) (from Ch. 46, par. 25-8)
- 15 Sec. 25-8. When a vacancy shall occur in the office of
- United States Senator from this state <u>more than one year before</u>
- 17 the next general election, the Governor shall issue to the
- 18 State Board of Elections a writ of election within 5 days after
- 19 the occurrence of that vacancy, appointing a day within 115
- 20 days to hold a special election to fill the vacancy. When a
- 21 vacancy shall occur in the office of United States Senator from
- this State one year or less before the next general election,

- 1 the Governor shall make temporary appointment to fill such
- 2 vacancy until the next election of representatives in Congress,
- 3 at which time such vacancy shall be filled by election. The τ
- 4 and the senator so elected pursuant to this Section shall take
- office as soon thereafter as he shall receive his certificate
- 6 of election.
