11 in 1965, where she was then baptized; she later served under
12 Pastor Alvin J. Wesley as his nurse until his death in June
13 2006; she also served her church faithfully as a member of the
14 Junior Choir, the Hermon Ensemble, the Hermon Senior Choir, the
Women's Guild, and the Nurse's Ministry; and

17 community; she helped start the Resident Management
18 Corporation and Tenant Patrol, and served as the secretary of
19 the Cabrini Green Local Advisor Council for many years; she

2003 until her death; and

2 and loved her as a very dedicated woman who would always help
3 those in need and as a true Christian who devoted her life
4 serving the Lord; and

7 Darryl; her grandchildren, Giovounta and Terirua; her
