2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Esther Caroline Ford Rapp of Wood River, 4 who passed away on April 19, 2008; and

5 WHEREAS, Esther Rapp was born on September 24, 1917 in East 6 Alton; his parents were Roy E. Ford and Sarah Margaret 7 (DeSilvey) Ford; she married John P. Rapp on July 8, 1970 in 8 Centralia; he preceded her in death on April 26, 1999; and

9 WHEREAS, Esther Rapp often reminisced about her childhood 10 years, which were filled with memories of the tile works once 11 located on present Olin property and adjacent to the boarding 12 house that belonged to her grandmother, Nancy (Stephens) 13 DeSilvey; and

14 WHEREAS, Esther Rapp proudly served her country during 15 World War II, enlisting in the United States Army Air Corps; 16 and
