SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

735 ILCS 30/25-5-25 new

Amends the Eminent Domain Act. Grants quick-take eminent domain powers for a period of one year to Kane County for the Stearns Road Corridor project. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Eminent Domain Act is amended by adding Section 25-5-25 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 30/25-5-25 new)
- Sec. 25-5-25. Quick-take; Kane County. Quick-take

 proceedings under Article 20 may be used for a period of 12

 months after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the

 following described properties for the purpose of road

 construction of the Stearns Road Corridor Project, including
- 14 PARCEL 1ST0030:
- That part of the East Half of Section 1, Township 40 North,

permanent easements and temporary easements.

- Range 8 East of the Third Principal Meridian described as
