1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 882

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 882 on page 3, by
3 replacing lines 20 through 26 with the following:

4 "final discharge, or release on parole or mandatory supervised
5 release, as a condition of his or her parole or mandatory
6 supervised release, or within 6 months from the effective date
7 of this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly, whichever
8 is sooner. Persons incarcerated on or after the effective date
9 of this amendatory Act of the 96th General Assembly shall be
10 required to submit a sample within 45 days of incarceration, or
11 prior to his or her final discharge, or release on parole or
12 mandatory supervised release, as a condition of his or her
13 parole or mandatory supervised release, whichever is sooner.
14 These specimens shall be placed into the State or national DNA
15 database, to be used in accordance with other provisions of
16 this Section, by the Illinois State Police."
