- to or prior approval of the University, so long as they do not 13
- represent that they are speaking for or on behalf of the 14

- Section 50. The Public Community College Act is amended by 16
- adding Section 3-29.4 as follows: 17
- 18 (110 ILCS 805/3-29.4 new)
- 19 Sec. 3-29.4. Faculty and staff contact with public
- 20 officials. All faculty and staff members of a community college
- 21 are free to communicate their views on any matter of private or
- public concern to any member of the legislative, executive, or 22

- judicial branch of government, State or federal, without notice 1
- 2 to or prior approval of the community college, so long as they
- 3 do not represent that they are speaking for or on behalf of the
- 4 community college.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 5
- 6 becoming law.
