1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1057 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 1057 on page 5, lines 19 and 20, by replacing "while the officer is performing 3 his or her official duties" with "whenever (i) an officer 4 assigned a patrol vehicle is conducting an enforcement stop; 5 6 (ii) when patrol vehicle emergency lights are activated or 7 would otherwise be activated if not for the need to conceal the 8 presence of law enforcement; or (iii) when using a taser or similar weapon or device equipped with a camera"; and 9 on page 5, line 24, by inserting after "agency" the following: 10 11 ". For the purposes of this subsection (h), "enforcement stop" means an action by a law enforcement officer in relation to 12 13 enforcement and investigation duties, including but not limited to, traffic stops, pedestrian stops, abandoned vehicle 14 contacts, motorist assists, commercial motor vehicle stops, 15 16 roadside safety checks, requests for identification, or

responses to requests for emergency assistance".
