

96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 HB2520

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 505/6.10 new

Amends the Children and Family Services Act. Provides that the Department of Children and Family Services shall provide a voucher in the amount of \$50 to low-income families to be applied to the purchase of a child restraint system that meets the requirements of the Child Passenger Protection Act. Defines "low-income family" to mean a family with household income equal to or less than 150% of the federal poverty level. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Children and Family Services Act is amended
- 5 by adding Section 6.10 as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 505/6.10 new)
- 7 Sec. 6.10. Voucher for child restraint system.
- 8 (a) In this Section, "low-income family" means a family
- 9 with household income equal to or less than 150% of the federal
- 10 poverty level, according to the poverty guidelines updated
- 11 periodically in the Federal Register by the U.S. Department of
- Health and Human Services under authority of 42 U.S.C. 9902(2).
- 13 (b) The Department shall provide a voucher in the amount of
- 14 \$50 to low-income families to be applied to the purchase of a
- child restraint system that meets the requirements of the Child
- Passenger Protection Act. A family may apply for a voucher in
- the form and manner prescribed by the Department.
- 18 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 19 becoming law.
