

## 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2009 and 2010 HB3637

Introduced 2/24/2009, by Rep. Keith Farnham

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 605/605-337 new

Amends the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Allows the Department to implement and administer a pilot program during fiscal years 2010 and 2011 to encourage businesses to restore, refurbish, and retrofit existing buildings that have been vacant for at least 90 continuous days so that a business is able to occupy the building as a retail, professional, corporate, manufacturing, assembly, or distribution business. Subject to appropriation, allows the Department may make interest free loans for this purpose, but loans may not be made for any building that would be used for residential purposes. Provides that loans shall be for a term of 10 years, and the borrower must repay at least 5% of the original principal amount of the loan each year and the balance at the end of the term. On or before April 1, 2011, requires the Department to report to the General Assembly on the effectiveness of the pilot program and recommend whether it should be extended. Effective July 1, 2009.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY 1 AN ACT concerning State government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by adding Section 605-337 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 605/605-337 new)
- Sec. 605-337. Restored vacant buildings; loan program. The 8 9 Department may implement and administer a pilot program during fiscal years 2010 and 2011 to encourage businesses to restore, 10 refurbish, and retrofit existing buildings that have been 11 12 vacant for at least 90 continuous days so that a business is able to occupy the building as a retail, professional, 13 14 corporate, manufacturing, assembly, or distribution business. Subject to appropriation, the Department may make interest free 15 loans for this purpose, but loans may not be made for any 16 17 building that would be used for residential purposes. Loans shall be for a term of 10 years, and the borrower must repay at 18 19 least 5% of the original principal amount of the loan each year 20 and the balance at the end of the term. On or before April 1, 21 2011, the Department shall report to the General Assembly on 22 the effectiveness of the pilot program and recommend whether it should be extended. 2.3
