1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding Section 15-1501.5 as follows:
- 6 (735 ILCS 5/15-1501.5 new)
- 7 Sec. 15-1501.5. Return from combat stay. In addition to any rights and obligations provided under the federal Service 8 9 members Civil Relief Act, whenever it is determined in a 10 foreclosure proceeding that the mortgagor defendant is a person who was deployed to a combat or combat support posting while on 11 12 active military duty and serving overseas within the previous 12 months, the court must stay the proceedings for a period of 13 14 90 days upon application to the court by the mortgagor defendant. "Active military duty" means, for purposes of this 15 16 Section, service on active duty as a member of the Armed Forces 17 of the United States, the Illinois National Guard, or any reserve component of the Armed Forces of the United States. 18
