1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 5

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to  
9 the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission:

5 Section 10. The amount of \$118,000, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
7 Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the  
8 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission for printing and  
9 distribution of Workers' Compensation handbooks containing  
10 information as to the rights and obligations of employers.

11 Section 15. The amount of \$255,000, or so much thereof  
12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
13 Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the  
14 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission for the  
15 implementation and operation of an accident reporting system.

16 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much  
17 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
18 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
19 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to  
20 the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission:

12           Section 25. The amount of \$1,150,000, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
14 Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois  
15 Workers' Compensation Commission for costs associated with  
16 the establishment, administration and operations of the  
17 Insurance Compliance Division of the workers' compensation  
18 anti-fraud program administered by Illinois Workers'  
19 Compensation Commission.

20           Section 30. The amount of \$225,000, or so much thereof  
21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois  
22 Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois  
23 Workers' Compensation Commission for costs associated with

1 the establishment of the Medical Fee Schedule and other  
2 provisions of the Workers' Compensation Act.

3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
4 2009.
